CLIMATE

Lake Howell High School offers 7 credits a year on a modified block schedule.

Students attend 90-minute period classes on alternating days.

Dual Enrollment

As per the Seminole County Public Schools Student Progression Plan, "Students enrolled in an approved dual enrollment course are exempt from the payment of registration, tuition, and laboratory fees for no more than nine credit hours per semester."

PROGRAMS OF EMPHASIS

Cyber Security

Lake Howell's Cyber Security Program introduces and prepares students for careers in computer science and cyber defense in multiple industries. This program includes industry certification and teaches the foundational knowledge and skills in computer and network security, security vulnerabilities, attack mechanisms and techniques, intrusion detection and prevention. In addition, students will learn cryptographic systems, system hardening, risk identification, incidence response, penetration testing, key management, access control, and recovery.

Culinary Arts

Lake Howell High School offers a multifaceted curriculum in preparation for the food service industry. Students gain experience with on-site catering while using commercial equipment, safety, and sanitary procedures. Lake Howell is also home to the Silver Hawk Cafe where students run their own restaurant servicing our faculty, staff, and students.

Entrepreneurship

Lake Howell's Entrepreneurship program curriculum introduces the broad spectrum of business, industry, and small business initiatives. Instruction focuses on business management and law and students have the opportunity to earn industry certification.



NEW Associate in Arts Degree Program in Business from Seminole State College

In conjunction with Seminole State College, Lake Howell's Associate Program in Business will culminate in both a high school diploma and an Associate in Arts degree in Business after four years. Incoming AAB 9th graders will begin their high school career just like any other incoming 9th grader. However, by the end of the first semester, students will need to have earned a College-Ready score on the PERT exam and a minimum of a 3.0 GPA in order to continue. This collegiate journey begins second semester with Speech and Introduction to Business taught by qualified, established Lake Howell instructors. In addition, AAB students have access to counselors that understand their needs and ambitions and will help them make informed decisions along the way.

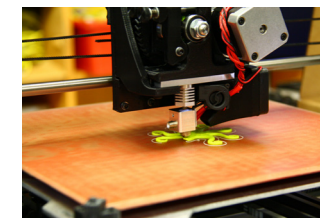
