



The following information is proposed to help clarify the Seminole County Public School dress code. This is just a guide. The complete dress code is posted online in the Student Conduct & Discipline Code page 16.

HEAD	Upper Garment	Lower Garment
<p>No caps, visors, hoods, beanie caps, bandanas, sunglasses as a head band, or other head gear may be worn on campus except with administrative permission. Hoodies can be worn, but the hood must be down.</p>	<p>No half-shirts, tube tops, backless tops/dresses, spaghetti straps, tank tops, camis, or A-type tank tops. No logos or artwork that depicts drugs, alcohol, that are sexually explicit, or condone violence may be worn. Shirts must touch the top portion of the lower garment at all times. The midriff area cannot show. Shirts cannot be "knotted" or tied to make shorter.</p>	<p>Undergarments and the buttocks MUST remain entirely covered even while seated. Dresses, skirts, and shorts must be at least mid-thigh on each individual and must cover the buttocks at all times. Rips, tears, or cuts above the mid-thigh are absolutely not permitted if skin is showing. Undergarments must not be visible through any rip, tear, or cut. Absolutely no undergarments can be visible.</p>
