### **Decorating Rules and Regulations:**

1. Have fun, be creative, and use your common sense when coming up with your design!
2. Follow the SCPS Code of Conduct rules for dress code: “Clothing, jewelry, and accessories shall not convey messages that are: crude, vulgar/profane, violent/death-oriented, gang related, sexually suggestive, or promote alcohol, drugs or tobacco.”
3. The design depicted must be an original creation. The design depicted on the actual cap must be that of the design, which was submitted and approved, no last-minute changes will be allowed.
4. If your design does not meet the criteria on the day of graduation, you will either need to purchase a new cap or you WILL NOT participate in the graduation ceremony. The LHHS Administration reserves the right to allow or not allow any and all decorations on your cap.

**To participate in graduation, you MUST wear a cap either with appropriate and approved artwork or no artwork at all. Not wearing a cap at graduation is NOT an option and if you are not wearing a cap, you will not participate in the ceremony.**

**LHHS Administration reserves the right to suggest alterations to any design submitted and it is advised for students to regularly check the comments on their submission for such feedback to be addressed.**
